

Use this slide as a focussing strategy to introduce the lesson topic. Read the title together and invite children to share something they know about how people today prepare for Jesus to come at Christmas.



Slide 3 God's people prepare to celebrate the coming of Jesus into the world

Use the information on the pop up to get children thinking and talking about those who waited for Jesus in the past and how people today prepare for his coming now. Use the red arrow as you read each item and encourage comments and questions. Look closely at the images in the collage and name all the ways people prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus today.

Slide 9 Check Up

This formative assessment strategy will help teachers to identify how well the children have achieved the Learning Intentions of the lesson.

Recording the children's responses to these items is recommended as it will enable teachers to adjust their learning strategies for future lessons and target the areas that need further attention.



children make their choice from their own copy.


Children could work on their choice at school and/or at home and you may like to set a day for sharing.


