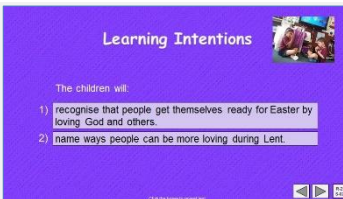

Slide 1 Getting ourselves ready for Easter

Use this slide as a focussing strategy to introduce the resource topic. Read the title together and invite children to share something they know about the season of Lent. Lent is when we get ready to celebrate Easter when Jesus rose from the dead.

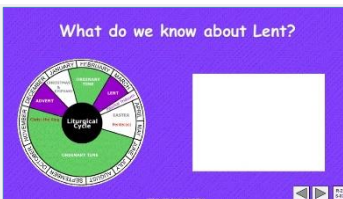

Slide 2 Learning Outcomes

Read through the Learning Intentions with the class and identify some ideas/questions that might be explored in the resource.

Slide 3 What do we know about Lent?

Teacher records what children know about Lent.

Refer to Lenten Calendar and the Children's Activity from the previous Resource 1.

Slide 4 Lent is a time to get ready for Easter

Read revealed text and invite children to talk about what the children are doing in the image. (Hongi) Explain what this is.

Children share ways they show love for children at school and as home.

Slide 5 We get ready for Easter by taking time to be with Jesus

Children look closely at the image and talk about what the children are doing. Read and follow the text.

Print off copies of the Children's Activity page 27 in the Teacher's Book or on the Resource Home page.

Slide 6 We try to follow Jesus as we get ready for Easter

Read and follow revealed text.

Slide 7 We show love to others when we notice if they are sad

Adapt Teaching and Learning Experience 3

Notice what is happening in the image.

Children make up a story about what has happened before the event, during the event and after the event. Answer the question about the girl.

When could you do what the girl is doing?

Slide 8 Can you name ways children can be helpful and loving in Lent?

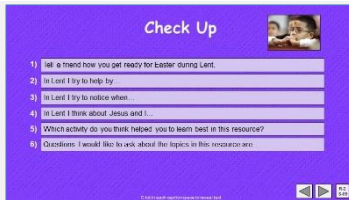
Teacher records children's ideas that answer the title question.

Slide 9 Check Up

This formative assessment strategy will help teachers to identify how well the children have achieved the Learning Intentions of the resource. Teachers can choose how they use the slide in their range of assessment options.
