Teacher's Notes

Slide 1 A Reminder to Live Justly

Use this slide as a focussing strategy to introduce the lesson topic. Read the title together and invite students to share something they know about what living justly means.

Use the Readings in class prayer during Lent.

Read the text on each flip card and respond to the questions. See information below.

FYI - The five books of the Pentateuch are Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy.

The 10 Commandments were given by God to Moses on Mount Sinai.

Leviticus is read in Lent because it is a time to focus on God's call to people to become holy as God is holy. Teacher's Notes



Slide 5 The Message of the Scripture Readings in Lent - Isaiah

Adapt Teaching and Learning Experience 1

Make copies of the Isaiah reading in the Teachers' book on p25 or in the Resource Documents for Yr 8 on the Resource Home page.

Read each post it note and imagine what the life of a prophet would have been like in Isaiah's day. You could research this and share your findings.

Read Isaiah 1:10, 16-20, 27-28

As you listen take note of:

- one action Isaiah urges the people to do that is God's teaching
- one warning he gives and the consequences of sinful behaviour
- share how Isaiah's advice and warning applies in today's world.
