




#### Slide 1 Pentecost is the Birthday of the Church


Use this slide as a focussing strategy to introduce the resource topic. Read the title together and invite children to share something they know about Pentecost and how it is the birthday of the Church.

Read the Bible story about Pentecost during class prayer this week.

#### Slide 3 Describe when Pentecost is celebrated in the Liturgical Year

Adapt Teaching and Learning Experience 1.

ANSWERS 1) Easter, 2) Ordinary Time, 3) Easter and Ordinary Time, 4) Birthday of the Church

Explain that Pentecost is the Feast when we celebrate the Holy Spirit giving the apostles the gifts they need to carry on the work Jesus began.

Take time for children to ask and answer questions about the Pentecost story.

Teacher's Notes

What happened before Pentecost

- Jesus lived in Nazareth and worked with his friends the apostles teaching the people about God his Father and how much he loved them.
- The rulers put Jesus to death and his followers were very frightened and sad. Jesus was buried in a tomb but rose after 3 days.
- The people loved Jesus but the way he lived and taught upset the rulers of his country.

## Slide 5A What happened before Pentecost?

Explain that Pentecost was a very important event for the followers of Jesus.

Use the post it notes to recap the life of Jesus and put the Pentecost event in context.

Remind the children of the Ascension story they heard last week and use it as a lead in to the post its on the next slide.

Teacher's Notes

What happened before Pentecost

- Jesus' followers were delighted that he had come back to them but he said them he was going to leave to God his Father in heaven soon. Jesus promised them he would follow him and send his Spirit to be with them always.
- About 10 days later the apostles were gathered together and they heard a sound like a rushing wind and saw a small what looked like a small fire above them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit. The day this happened we call Pentecost.

## Slide 5B What happened before Pentecost?

Share the post it notes and recap the Ascension story. Around the class circle children can retell what happened at Pentecost and explain that after it the followers of Jesus became a new group or community who were filled with the Holy Spirit and they would carry on the work Jesus started. This is how the Church began and why we say Pentecost is the birthday of the Church.




## Slide 7 What happened to the disciples after Pentecost?

Read through the flip cards and discuss what the disciples did after the Holy Spirit came.

Explain how they changed and that after Pentecost the disciples were no longer a frightened little group but a strong big group that

kept growing into a community with a special purpose - to carry on the work Jesus had started. It was the power of the Holy Spirit that helped this to happen.



## Slide 9 Check Up

## Slide 10 Time for Reflection
