

This privacy policy applies to your use of the software application nzpray2day, hereafter called “Application”, for mobile devices that is owned by The Good Shepard College. This privacy policy is effective as of 1 September, 2020 and may change from time to time for any reason. Users of the Application are advised to check the latest version of this privacy policy on this website or to contact us with any questions or concerns about our privacy policies.

What information does the Application obtain and how is it use?

The Application does not require you to provide any personally identifiable information about you, such as your name, address, phone number or email address. All information that is provided to the application in the “My Journal” section is stored locally on the mobile device. The Application has no facility to share that information either within the mobile device or to externally. This locally stored information will be deleted when the Application is removed from the device.

How does the Application handle location data?

The Application does not use or collect any data related to your geographic location.

Can users see their personal data?

Users can only see the data that they have entered in the “My Journal” section of the Application. That data is stored locally on the mobile device and is not shared outside the Application.

Is any data shared by the Application?

The Application has no facility to share information either within the mobile device (e.g. to other applications) or externally.

Do advertising companies collect data?

The Application has no facility to share information, so no data is shared with advertising companies or any other party.

Does the application provide or use vendors or analytics providers?

No. The Application has no facility for sharing data with vendors or analytics providers. Analytics information that is collected by Application providers (e.g Google Play or Apple App Store) is not used by the owner of the Application

Do you comply with the Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)?

Yes. We do not solicit any data from persons either under or over the age of 13. If a parent or guardian becomes aware that his or her child has provided the Application with information without their consent, he or she can contact us.
